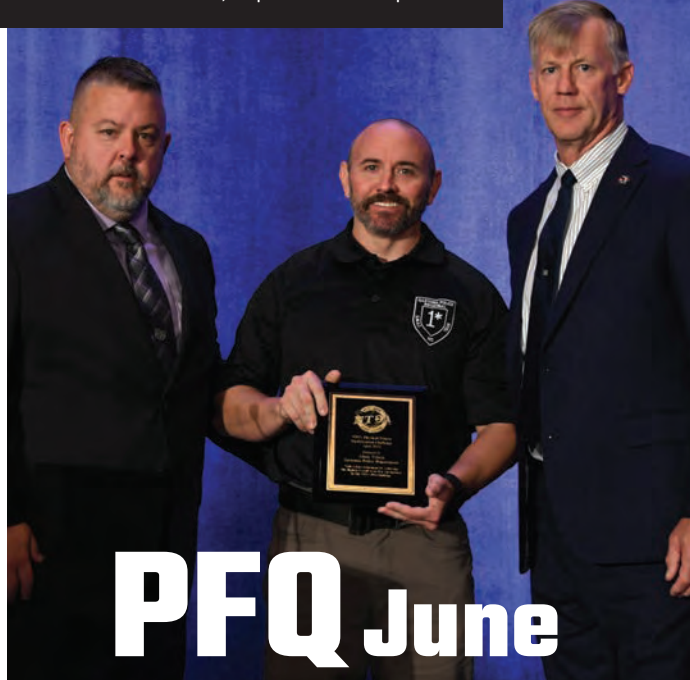

The NTOA conducted its second annual PFQ Challenge during the month of June 2022. All operators who successfully maxed the test with 50 points are listed on page 65. Furthermore, the top 10 scores received a formal certificate of achievement from the NTOA on their accomplishment and a 1-year membership. The agency or SWAT team that submitted the highest overall score also is listed on page 65 and received a plaque commemorating their achievement.

It is with great pleasure that the NTOA Physical Fitness section acknowledges and celebrates the best of the best within our nation’s ranks of ERT and SWAT operations for their remarkable achievements on the NTOA PFQ. These people have stood out as possessing levels of strength, endurance, speed, and fortitude that set them apart and position them at the tip of the spear. Special recognition is in order for Det.
